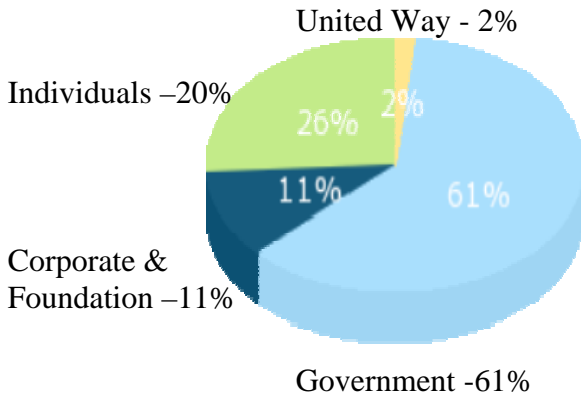

For the year ended June 30, 2010



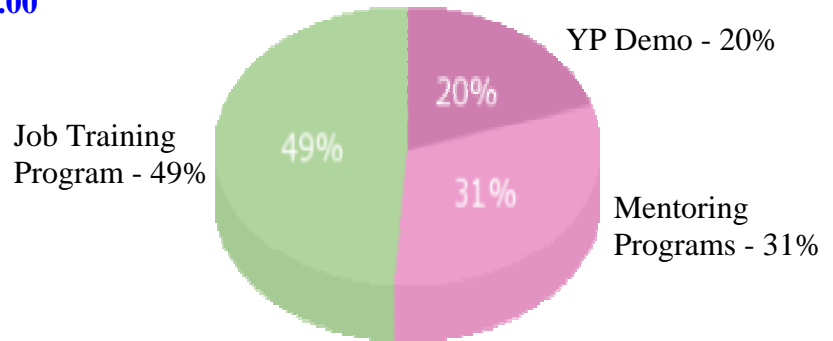
Percentage of Expenses by Program Percent

Key Facts

- ~~ In June of 2010 and for the preceding four years all participating seniors in the Young Parents Support Network program graduated from high school. Nine graduated in June and over forty percent went on to post-secondary education.
- ~~No teen parents in YPSN have become pregnant while participating in the program for the last five years. Twenty-nine teen parents participated in the program in the last year. All twenty in grades 6 through 11 were promoted to the next grade.
- ~~From July 2009 to June 2010 every woman who completed one year in the WomenCare mentoring program reached at least one of her self-sufficiency goals, like getting a job, getting back custody of a child, or obtaining a house.
- ~~ Over 20 disadvantaged older youth were placed at 11 employer sites in our ARRA Work Readiness Job Training Program. They received a combined total of 10,892 hours of work experience, job readiness and literacy/numeracy training.
- ~~ Between January and June 2010 twelve young parents (aged 16-24) have enrolled in the 'bump up' demonstration program and received over 88 hours of mentoring, job coaching, financial literacy/life skills training, and job search assistance.
